



Enter and work in confined spaces

Programme Overview

This unit covers the entering and working in confined spaces in resources and infrastructure industries. It includes planning and preparing for entry of confined spaces; entry and working in confined spaces, exiting confined spaces and cleaning up. The program includes:

- Legislation
- Confined Spaces (definition, general hazards, personnel)
- Atmospheres, gas detection equipment and monitoring
- Emergency Response, PPE, Safety Equipment
- Hazard identification
- Entry procedure and entry permit

Certification
